Minutes of May 2016 EAA 402 Meeting

The meeting, in the clubhouse, was called to order at 1901 by Vice President Rollie Bailey and was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. There were 22 members present.

Secretary's Report: Minutes of the April meeting were approved as printed in the May newsletter. Motion to accept was made by Carl Braddock, seconded by Bob Marriott and accepted by all.

- In the absence of the secretary Rollie, speaking from Tom's notes, said that we need to confirm pilots for YE and call Bernie personally to confirm. We need help in all phases the morning of June 11. Michael Harris is taking care of publicity, Ralph Brandon, in the absence of Hanne McFadden will do the registration, Gary Kurtz will print certificates, Carl Oblinger will take photos. We need a few more people to assist Ralph to make things flow well.
- Bill Corban and Tom installed the sign on our clubhouse rear window, Bill had the vinyl transfer sign made at a cost of about \$40.

Treasurer's Report: Ken's report was read by Rollie. The starting balance as of May 17th was \$3254.39. Membership dues received were \$48.00. Contributions to the utility fund \$32.00. Donations to general fund, \$3.00; Cheryl Volpe fund \$40.00; Utilities paid: \$78.62. Other expenses: Bernie Volpe (rebate) \$40.00; Bill Corban for storm door repair \$59.47. Ending balance: \$3207.30. Included in the balance, were \$282.25 in the Utility Fund; \$308.88 in the Young Eagles Fund; \$940.00 in the Jack Maki Memorial Fund and \$100 in the Beacon/Marker Restoration fund. Larry Arnold moved to accept the report, the motion was seconded by Barney Kemter and accepted by the members present.

Newsletter Editor: Rollie pointed out the numerous errors in the newsletter. Wendy apologized for the additional errors in the printed version which was rushed out for mailing.

Fly-out Report: The First-Sunday fly out, to Swank, was cancelled due to weather. This coming Saturday weather looks iffy for the fly-out to the Cloud Nine Restaurant in Big Sandy KY. Check in with Rollie to confirm.
