## Minutes of October 2018 EAA402 Meeting

The regular meeting, held at the chapter clubhouse, was called to order at 1900 hours by President Barney Kemter who opened the meeting with the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. There were fourteen members present.

Barney shared that Tom Thompson's wife Kathy passed away also, services for Sam Huff's were just held at McPeck-Hoestra Funeral Home in Granville.

**Secretary's Report:** The president asked for additions or corrections to the minutes as printed in the newsletter. None were forthcoming. Motion to accept the minutes as published in the newsletter was made by Rollie Bailey, seconded by Charlie Rhoads and passed by the members.

**Treasurer's Report:** Treasurer Ken Hughes presented the report dated October 16, 2018. The starting balance was \$3110.47. Contributions of \$16.00 were received to the Utility Fund. Miscellaneous receipts to the general fund: \$75.00 received for advance payment of Christmas dinners. Utilities costs paid were \$87.62. Young Eagles expenses were \$125.00 for Affordable Portables. \$68.90 was spent for funeral flowers for Cheryl Huff. Ending balance was \$2919.095 including reserves. Bernie Volpe mentioned the increased in donation to Young Eagles (\$500) from VFW this year. The members thanked him. Motion to accept the report was made by Jim Wright and seconded by Bernie Volpe. The motion carried.

**Fly-Out Report:** The October 7th fly-out was to Eagle Creek (KEYE) near Indianapolis and the beautiful restaurant overlooking the lake. Rollie reports that the weather was good and air races were going on! The 3rd Saturday fly-out, October 20th will be to Rostraver, PA.

**Airport Board Report** made by Rollie Bailey:

Rollie reiterated that the FAA came through with 95% of the taxiway realignment money for next year. The remaining 5% will come from a county bond. The work will be delayed until Spring and should be much cheaper then.

### Old Business:

- **Items for Christmas dinner:** The secretary reported through email that the speaker has been confirmed. Ken is taking advance payment for dinners and Barney asked Ken if we could use the Square (credit card reader) for payments (on site, I presume) and Ken said yes. Wendy suggested that we increase the dinner price to cover the processing fee then provide a discount for check or cash payment. We agreed to set the price to \$27 for credit card (or PayPal on the website) and \$25 for cash or check.
- **Gas Grill:** Carl O. discussed a Sears model for \$399 and Rollie suggested we go another \$100 for a stainless model and it was passed by voice vote.
- Bob Marriott reminded Barney about his offer to contact Jim Carter

- The secretary reported through email to the president that the EAA national and chapter memberships for John Roush has been taken care of.
- Young Eagles follow up: On Saturday September 22nd three pilots and a group of ground volunteers managed to fly off the balance of the kids who came out for the September 15th rally. Bill Corban flew 15, Jeff Wheeler flew 13 and Bernie flew 12. These flights were all pre-arranged by Bill and Tom prior to the day of the event. Thirty-two of the kids were first-timers.

### **New Business:**

- President Barney presented information about EAA Scholarship, and we all he should sign up the chapter for the program. We have the understanding that those we sponsor we would be expected to mentor, and we are not entirely sure we would have the resources. The members agreed that the first step was getting signed up and Barney should move forward with that.
- We have been reached out to about hosting the EAA Ford Tri-Motor next year. A July schedule was tossed out. Wendy moved that we get more information about the requirements so we could make a more informed decision. Jim Wright seconded the motion and all agreed.

### **Project Reports**

Dave Minnich said his plane is flying and Dan's is ready. Announcements: Someone reported that the FAA has re-instated the \$500 ADSB Out rebate. (Search for "ADSB Rebate Program" on the internet for full information. Sec.)

**Adjournment:** The meeting was adjourned at approximately 1957.
