Minutes of March 2016 EAA 402 Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 1900 by President Berne Volpe at the chapter clubhouse. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. There were twenty members present. Special member/guest Roy McGrew.

Secretary's Report: The secretary asked for approval of the February minutes as printed in the March newsletter. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Larry Arnold, seconded by Rollie Bailey. The motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Ken Hughes gave the report including the final report of the Christmas dinner expense. The ending balance as of March 15th was \$3163.11. Contributions to the utility fund \$59.00; income from dues \$24.00; donations to the Jack Maki Memorial Fund \$440.00; final Christmas dinner payment of \$25 was received and a payment to the Cheryl Volpe fund of \$100.00 was made. Utilities paid: \$113.17. Other expenses: \$137.24 reimbursements to Tom McFadden. Included in the balance, were \$389.89 in the Utility Fund, \$308.88 in the Young Eagles Fund and \$890.00 in the Jack Maki Memorial Fund. A motion to accept the report was made by Larry Arnold, seconded by Bob Marriott and approved by all members present.

Rollie Bailey asked for the floor for a few minutes to tell his story about our member Roy McGrew. Roy doesn't make many meeting these day but this was his 90th birthday and Rollie made sure to get him to this meeting so we could celebrate with him. Paraphrasing Rollie: Rollie told of meeting Roy in church many years ago, perhaps 1983. They struck up a friendship over time and one Sunday morning Roy asked Rollie if he would like to go flying with him. Rollie was reluctant at first as he had not yet been bitten by the bug. They did go the next Sunday and many Sundays after that even taking some long flights to St. Louis and other places. At some point Roy became incapacitated and couldn't fly

anymore and Rollie had serious withdrawal - to the point the he decided to get his own license and plane. Rollie has subsequently taken Roy and many others of us on flights and fly-outs.

Fly Out Report: Rollie reported on a the recent fly-out to Carrollton-Carroll County (TSO). Six or seven airplanes went and the weather was beautiful. The March 19th fly-out will be to Circleville (CYO) with an 8:30AM departure.

Airport Board Report by Bill Corban

The lease agreement of the clubhouse is being taken care of.

- Request for bids are out for repairing the paving.
- Requests for bids are out for re-striping the taxiways.
- A contractor has expressed interest in bidding on design and building of the new hangars. This would be a two phase project. It has become too late to get in on the county bonds this cycle and will need to wait for the next cycle.

Old Business:

The secretary reminded the members of the need to take the course and get the background check and get the certification for the Youth Protection Program before the June Young Eagles Rally.

New Business:

Young Eagles Credits. The secretary reported that the chapter has earned 144 credits with a value of \$720. Tom explained that the credits can be used for EAA Air Academy Scholarships, local Young Eagles support and activities or turned back to EAA to enhance the general Air Academy scholarship fund. Ken Hughes said he had been approached by EAA members at Lancaster about pooling credits to send a youth to the academy. Bill Corban suggested that we look into sending a CAP cadet to the academy. A motion was made by Bill Corban that a committee be formed to check with the CAP and also look into the other possibilities. The motion was not seconded and voted on but Barney Kemter, Ken Hughes and Tom McFadden volunteered to make up such a committee.

The Works: Wendy Hollinger brought us up to date on the static display of a full size Cessna Dale Ratcliff is building for the Works. Steve Brown has agreed to paint the tail section although, in a meeting at the Works, Steve convinced those planning the display that it would not be a good idea to hang the tail section on the outside wall of the building. Wendy asked for help to haul the plane assemblies from the Parkersburg, where Dale is working on them, to Newark. They need at least two trucks and trailers on or about May 21st to haul the fuselage and wings, etc. to Newark. The opening date for the Display at the Works is planned for June 18th. Anyone available to help can contact Wendy or Dale.

Projects:

- Steve Brown has been working on wiring of the panel in his RV14 project. Steve said there are 900 wires involved. He is still awaiting his engine.

50/50 Drawing


The drawing was won by Earl Gossett who donated his winnings to the utility fund. Announcements:
