Minutes of May 2017 EAA 402 Meeting

The meeting, held at the chapter clubhouse, was called to order at 1900 by Vice President Rollie Bailey and was opened with the pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. There were twenty members present.

Secretary Report: The secretary asked for additions or corrections to the minutes of the April meeting as published in the newsletter and then pointed several corrections that needed to be made. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Jim Wright, seconded by Ralph Brandon. A vote was taken and the motion carried.

Treasurers Report: Ken Hughes presented the report. The starting balance as of 4/18/2017 was \$2,827.86. Dues payments received \$72.00. Contributions to the Utility Fund were \$91.00. Donation made to Young Eagles reserves were \$301.00 (\$300 from VFW, \$1.00 from Miscellaneous). Expenses were \$81.02 for utilities. Ending balance as of 5/16/2017 was \$3250.24. Reserves included in the ending balance are \$840 in the Jack Maki Fund, \$100 in the Beacon Marker Fund, \$178.00 in the Utility fund and \$414.96 in the Young Eagles Fund for a total of \$1532.96 in fund reserves. Ken made note that the Young Eagles fund does not usually cover all the expenses for two events a year and some money usually comes out of the general fund.

Ken also made note that we will soon need to pay the balance of the Air Academy tuition for James DeForest Kemter to EAA. This will come out of the Jack Maki fund as previously agreed to. Motion to accept the report was made by Barney Kemter and seconded by Bob Marriott. The motion carried.

Newsletter: Wendy Hollinger, newsletter editor and all around good person, spoke of the recent event at Port Columbus, John Glenn International Airport during which Shaesta Waiz arrived at the airport on the first stop of her planned solo circumnavigation of the globe. Wendy thanked 402 for all the participation and help she received in setting up the welcoming and bon voyage for Shaesta, and other activities at Signature Aviation over the two days the young female pilot was here.

Fly-Out Report: Rollie Bailey, in his role of fly-Out coordinator, reported on the May 7th fly-out to Wayensburg/ Green County,PA (KWAY). The conditions on the morning of May 7th were MVFR and several pilots decided to go West where the weather was VFR. Pilots Charlie Rhoads, Rollie Bailey and Carl Braddock and their passengers did go to KWAY and were pleased with their flight, transportation and meals. The fly-Out Saturday, May 20th will be to Wadsworth, OH (3G3) where there will be food, a car show and other features. Departure from VTA will be at 0830.

Airport Board: Rollie Bailey, made the report.

- Rollie reported that three new hangars will be built.
- Monty Black has offered the MPW hangar and fuel truck to the airport board for approximately \$600,000.
- A 480V purge-pump is to be installed in the reclamation area. Rollie commented that there is a “a lot going on here.”

Old Business:

A review of the status of the planning for the Young Eagles Rally of June 10th was conducted. Tom reported that the application for event insurance has been submitted and the statement-of-coverage has been received and that registration supplies have been ordered and received. Pilots so far committed are: Bernie Volpe, Tom McFadden (if needed), Charlie Rhoads, Michael Harris, Ken Hughes, Rollie Bailey, Jim Wright, Jeff Wheeler (a good maybe) and George Fackler. The Weinermeister and crew (Larry Arnold and Carl Braddock) will be doing hot dogs. Larry will pick up all supplies for this including ice. Ground crew so far committed: Registration, Hanne McFadden, Ralph Brandon, Gary and Molly Kurtz, Marie Hughes, Wendy Hollinger, Carl Oblinger, Katrina Snook, Chuck Snook, and Bruce Pickard. The Civil Air Patrol is also committed to help. Mike Harris will do the media publicity. Tom provided posters at the last meeting and this meeting to all members for posting.

New Business:

501c(3): Treasurer Ken Hughes asked that the members think about whether we should become a 501c(3) entity. There are advantages and disadvantages which Ken mentioned. Member Michael Harris, Tax

Motion to adjourn was made by Michael Harris, seconded by Jim Wright and passed by the members. The meeting was adjourned at 1955.
