Parr Airport Overnight Fly-out Invitation

Valerie Norman of Parr Airport wrote: we have 2 overnight trips this year. The first is Aug 16-17 to Niagara Falls. We will be flying into the Niagara Falls International Airport. Though some purchased passports last year in anticipation of this trip, we will still be staying on the American side. Those wishing to go to the Canadian side may do so. I have rooms booked at the Econolodge at The Falls. \$188.96 plus tax. They offer a free continental breakfast, wi-fi, and an outdoor heated pool, game room and playground. There is also free shuttle service to The Falls, but it is located at 5919 NiagaraFalls Boulevard, so it is within walking distance also.

The second overnight is a repeat destination from last year's alternative trip when we planned to go to Niagara Falls! We will be going to Lunken Airport in Cincinnati on Sept. 6-7. I could not get rooms at the same hotel as last year, but have booked rooms at the Hampton Inn, Cincinnati, Riverfront (don't let the name fool you! the hotel is still in Covington, Kentucky). These are also standard rooms with 2 queen beds each at the amount of \$189. They also have free high speed internet and an indoor pool and a continental breakfast (I think!). This is the weekend for the Oktoberfest in the Main Strauss Village which we attended last year.

Minutes of June 2014 EAA 402 Meeting

The meeting was called to order by President Charlie Rhoads at 7:00 PM. There were nineteen members and one guest, Craig Wolfe, present. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Secretary's Report: A motion to accept the minutes of the May meeting as printed in the June newsletter was made by Wendy Hollinger, seconded by Bob Boyd and passed by the members present.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Ken Hughes gave the financial report. The starting balance was \$1514.24. Income from dues paid: \$60.00. Income from donations: \$51.00. Income from 50/50 drawing was \$30.00. General Contributions \$289.32. Expenses paid: were \$138.85. Ending balance: \$1,805.71 including Utility reserves of \$58.23 and Young Eagles Reserves of \$609.43. Ending balance less reserves was \$1,138.05. Motion to accept the report was made by Rollie Bailey, seconded by Carl Braddock and passed by the members present.

Fly-Out Report: The 3rd Saturday of June Fly-Out, June 21st is planned for Windwood WV (WV62). Depart VTA at 8:00AM. Rollie says the KOOP Group cook out is also Saturday afternoon. There will not be a fly-out on July 6th in favor of family activities over the Independence Day Holidays. The fly-out July 19th will be to Sporty's.

Newsletter: Wendy apologized for getting the newsletter out so late again.

Airport Board: Rollie reported that the patch work has been done on taxiway Bravo; the fate of the Swifty property is still unknown; bids are out for painting the older T-hangars and a mechanic, Jeff Furay, has been hired. Rollie mentioned that 402 needs to follow through with our plan to paint the historic numbers on the beacon shed.

Old Business:

- June 14th Young Eagles Rally report by Tom McFadden: Eight pilots flew 91 kids: Brandon -11; Russell-4; Hughes-9; Kemter-4; Harris-14; Bailey-21; Wheeler-15; Wright-14. Sixteen volunteers, chapter members and friends and ten Civil Air patrol cadets and adult leaders helped pull off a very successful day. Chapter members and friends at registration were Marie Hughes, Marie Bailey, Chuck Snook, Hanne McFadden, Tom McFadden, Gary Kurtz, Katie Snook and Peggy Abell. Larry Arnold and Tim Hail provided the food service and served 120 hot dogs. Kenny Rauch lead the auto parking. Bob Marriott was the ground crew leader. Bob R. Bennett demonstrated his ultralight to many, many kids. Carl Oblinger took photos of the kids and Wendy printed them out. Gary Kurtz printed out certificates. Charlie Rhoads sold T-shirts, hats, mugs, 50/50 tickets and chances on the quadcopter that Carl Oblinger donated. The sales and donations grossed about \$293. Hot dogs were served free to the kids and the volunteers. Tom praised and thanked all who helped but said we could use a few more volunteers at the fall event. Tom apologized if he has overlooked anyone who helped.

New Business

There was some discussion of the Fly-In breakfast August 16th. Charlie suggested that we might have a plane wash at the event. The secretary
