## Minutes of August 2015 EAA 402 Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 1900 by President Bernie Volpe. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. There were fifteen members and 3 visitors, Eric Large, Caleb Large and Ryan Haught, present.

**Secretary's Report:** The secretary asked for any additions or corrections to the minutes of the July meeting as printed in the August newsletter. Motion to accept was made by Rollie Bailey seconded by Jim Wright and passed by the members present.

**Treasurer's Report:** Treasurer Ken Hughes gave the report. The balance as of August 18, 2015 was \$3,573.62. Contributions to the utility fund were \$186.00. Income from the fly-in is as follows: 50/50 drawing \$121.00; cash donations \$20.00; PIC prizes of \$50.00 each from Rollie Bailey, Dick Perdue and Aviation Works; Drone raffle \$86.00 (Drone donated by Carl Oblinger); breakfast proceeds of \$1444.00; merchandise sales of \$130.00. Cost of the fly-in \$1147.17. Utilities paid: \$70.24. An itemized record of income and expenses is maintained by the treasurer. Reserves, included in the balance, were \$466.62 in the Utility Fund and \$448.88 in the Young Eagles Fund. Motion to accept the report was made by Rollie Bailey, seconded by Charlie Moore and passed by the members present.

**Fly-out Report:** Rollie reported that the fly-out to Swank Field was a success and mostly tail draggers went.

Larry Arnold said he is trying to get a group up to fly to Morgan County and the Stockport Mill Inn. The date will be October 18th and time is 10:30AM. Larry said it is a very nice place and the price is about \$20 for a meal and \$5 for transportation. He needs about 15 people to go. Watch for further information via email.

The first-Sunday fly out is scheduled to go to Mt. Victory but Tom suggested it could be to New Philadelphia to EAA 1077's fly-in breakfast and DC-3 event. Tom posted a flyer on the board in case anyone was interested.

### **Old Business:**

- Fly-In Evaluation: Ken suggested, as have others, that we may want to evaluate our layout and our publicity to see if we can bring in more planes next time. We had seventeen planes registered but we think there were a number of pilots that landed but did not come to eat breakfast and did not register. Also, many of the drive-ins may have not known to go out and look at the cars and planes.
- Rollie suggested that we purchase more tables so we don't have to borrow them and haul them from the church. A motion was made by Bernie Volpe that we spend up to \$500 on additional tables. The motion was seconded by Dan Glaze. After considerable discussion a vote was taken and passed by the members. A collection was also taken to add more money for the purchase of tables. Charlie Rhoads was authorized to watch for bargains and purchase tables.
- Tom suggested that we start the Fly-In planning earlier next year and more people give input to all parts of the event.

### **New Business:**

- Planning for Young Eagles Rally of September 12th. Seven pilots volunteered to fly kids that day. Larry Arnold and Carl Braddock will cook hot dogs. Larry will pick up supplies. Michael Harris will do the local publicity. Tom will see to the forms and certificates, insurance, portable toilet and registration volunteers. Our work party was set for Friday evening to get set up as much as possible so there is less work on Saturday morning.
