
Historic Stockport Mill Inn

Minutes of September 2015 EAA 402 Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 1852 by President Bernie Volpe. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. There were sixteen members present.

Secretary's Report: The secretary asked for any additions or corrections to the minutes of the August meeting as printed in the September newsletter. Motion to accept was made by Charlie Moore seconded by Carl Braddock and passed by the members present.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Ken Hughes gave the report. The balance as of September 15, 2015 was \$3,284.51. Contributions to the utility fund were \$71.00. Utilities paid: \$78.94. Other expenses: \$224.00 T-shirt purchase; \$277.41 Fly-In expenses; Cash received: \$220.00 from the table fund; \$3.25 from water sales; \$50.00 returned fly- in prize money from Dave Johnson. An itemized record of income and expenses is maintained by the treasurer. Reserves, included in the balance, were \$458.68 in the Utility Fund and \$304.17 in the Young Eagles Fund. Motion to accept the report was made by Rollie Bailey, seconded by Jim Wright and passed by the members present.

Airport Board Report: made by Rollie Bailey. First item; the dip in the taxiway for the tail dragger hangars will be repaired. Second item; the board is investigating what can be stored in the Koch buildings. Third item; some additional trees need to be trimmed. Fourth *continued on page 3*
