Minutes of October 2016 EAA 402 Meeting

Secretary's Report: The secretary asked for approval of the minutes of the September 15, 2016 meeting. Motion to accept the minutes was made by Rollie Bailey, seconded by Jim Wright and accepted by the members present.

Additional Reports: The secretary showed a picture from the Newark Advocate of Carl Oblinger being honored for 54 years at the COATC (Newark AFS). In the picture Carl was wearing his red chapter 402 hat.

Treasurer's Report: Ken Hughes gave the treasurer's report. The starting balance as of September 19th was \$3,134.23. Dues received

from new members \$12.00. Contributions to the utility fund \$59.00. Utilities paid: \$78.97. Other costs and expenses: \$371.20. Ending Balance October 18, 2016 was \$2,755.06. Reserves: Jack Maki Memorial Fund \$840; Beacon/Marker Restoration Fund \$100; Utility Fund \$393.95; Young Eagles fund \$113.96. Outstanding receipts: \$621.23 (reimbursement from spent EAA for YE credits.) Ending balance less reserves plus outstanding receipts \$1,928.38. Motion to accept the report was made by Larry Arnold, was seconded by Carl Braddock and accepted by the members present.

Fly-out Report: Rollie reported that the Fly-out to Rostraver (KFWQ) at Monongahela, PA on October 15th. Departed VTA at 8:30am. Weather was good and the flight was good. 4 1/2 planes (ask Rollie about this) flew over including Den Paccot, our new member from Chile, who flew himself in a Aviation Works rental. Rollie also reported on the previous fly-out to the Morgan County Airport (171) and the Stockport Mill Inn. Five plane loads went on this one. Great pictures by Ken Hughes.

First Sunday of November fly-Out will be to Urbana-Grimes and the third Saturday will be to Anderson, Indiana.

Airport Board: Rollie gave the report. Some items discussed by the board: lengthening of the first two rows of hangars; light by the gas pumps; purchase of property north of the runway.
