Minutes of November 2015 EAA 402 Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 1900 by President Berne Volpe. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. There were nineteen members and two guests present.

Secretary’s Report: In the absence of the Secretary, Wendy asked for corrections to the minutes of the October meeting as printed in the November newsletter. Rollie provided a correction to his Airport Board Report. He said he did propose that the airport board recover the land on the side of the runway, but that it does not have anything to do with the Shai House. Barney motioned to accept the minutes as printed, with the necessary change incorporated, and Rollie seconded. It was approved by the members present.

Treasurer’s Report: Treasurer Ken Hughes gave the report. The ending balance as of November 17, 2015 was \$2499.28. Contributions to the utility fund were \$105.00. Income from dues was \$72.00. Income from scrap metal sales was \$00.00. Other Income was \$1641.22 including Sheryl Volpe fund. Utilities paid: \$79.06. Other expenses: \$1924.94 including pay-out of Sheryl Volpe fund. Reserves, included in the balance, were \$397.61 in the Utility Fund and \$308.88 in the Young Eagles Fund. A motion to accept was made by Rollie and seconded by Barney, and approved by all members present.

Fly-out Report: Rollie said the last fly-out was the first Sunday of November. Due to weather (IFR by the river) they went to Urbana-Grimes instead. It was a nice flight and there was a nice tail-wind on the return. This Saturday is the fly-out to Sporty’s, departing at 10:30. We will continue to have fly-outs as long as the weather holds.

Airport Board Report: Bill Corban said the discussion was on some big ticket items, including 1) another string of hangars as the FBO continues to get inquiries about more hangar space. 2) The board is interested in acquiring a long strip of land (that Rollie referred to in his correction to the minutes), in order to comply with FAA standards of clearance, which we do not currently meet. 3) Some mention of a taxiway issue, no detail recorded. 4) The board has been holding off taking money available to them from FAA, in order to build up a fund, since they will be required to come up with matching funds. 4) Still working with George Fackler regarding the use of the Koch building.

Old Business:

- Christmas dinner meeting: Larry said a committee was formed to select the site for the meeting to be held on December 15th. They considered Longaberger Golf Club, Trout Club, Harbor Hills Country Club, Davis Shai House, and the Yacht Club. The Yacht did not respond to inquiries. The Harbor Hills Country Club was selected, in part to bring business to the lake since they’ve been struggling due to the low water. The all-inclusive cost will be \$25 per person. The caterer invited Larry and a group from 402 to visit an event he was catering and try the food. The menu will be coffee, tea, lemonade, a cash bar will be available, garden salad, rolls, Caribbean glazed honey ham.
