

Charlie Rhoads offered his camera. Discussion followed and it was decided that we will purchase a new one, with warranty, for the FBO. Dan Glaze volunteered to make the purchase. Motion was made by Bill Corban to authorize Dan to spend up to \$150 of chapter funds on the purchase. Motion was seconded by Bernie Volpe and passed by the members.

New Business
