## A Call to Chapter Action

So, please be present next Tuesday for the nomination process.

The other item of importance is the December meeting. It was discussed to some extent at the last meeting and your club officers have investigated several options. Larry Arnold has arranged for a guest speaker to give up to a 30-minute presentation at the meeting (details to be announced.) ## Minutes of September 21, 2010 EAA 402 Meeting

The meeting, at the clubhouse, was called to order by Vice President Rollie Bailey at 7:00pm. There were thirteen members present. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

**Secretary:** Minutes of the August meeting were accepted on motion by Dan Glaze, second by Jess Ours and vote of the members.

**Treasurer:** Treasurer Larry Arnold gave his report. Starting balance was \$2,317.19. Income was \$48.00. Expenses paid were \$369.40. Ending balance was \$2458.79. Utility Reserves \$97.17; Young Eagles reserves \$54.41. Motion to accept the report was made by Dan Glaze, seconded by Dale Ratcliff and passed by the members.

**Membership:** Dale reports that he continues to promote EAA whenever he can. Speaking of another dimension of membership, Dale told of his experience of going out to Kenny's farm and giving him moral support after Kenny's unfortunate accident. Dale also reported on the successful Fly-In at Hales Landing.

### Old Business:

- **Fly-In/YE Rally**—The group discussed the recent fly-in and YE rally.
  - It was noted there were 37 planes coming in for breakfast and 135 Young Eagles were flown.
  - The chapter made \$475.00 before expenses but after the caterer received her share. Expenses were \$310.70. The chapter cleared \$164.30. The Porta-John, approximately \$80 has not yet been paid.
  - It was reported that the caterer ran out of food early and there were some unsatisfied pilots. Part of the problem was that the caterer gave out seconds which was not planned for.
  - There was one incident where a very irate visiting pilot claimed one of our YE aircraft cut in front of him in the pattern. The incident was confirmed by several observers. Dale and Tom both talked to the visiting pilot and tried to ease the situation. Tom discussed the incident with the 402 pilot.
  - Chapter members spoke about the congestion in the air and on the ground with so many YE planes flying and so many visiting aircraft. Tom suggested we not combine the YE rally with the Fly-In next year but rather hold separate events. Some of the members agreed and it was decided to table the discussion until the appropriate time.
- **CAP Campout**—Rollie reported on the CAP campout on the airport. Several of the chapter members helped out and it appeared the event was a success.

### New Business:

**December Meeting Venue**—The secretary asked for suggestions for the meeting place for the December 21st meeting. Tom suggested the Davis-Shai House and Larry suggested the Yacht Club at Buckeye Lake. Tom
