Minutes of June 19, 2012 EAA 402 Meeting

The meeting, held at the clubhouse, was called to order by the president, Bob Boyd, at 1900 hrs. There were twenty members present. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Note: The minutes are reported here in the normal order although some business was conducted out of order to allow some attendees to depart early.

Secretary: The minutes of the May 2012 meeting were accepted as printed in the June 2012 newsletter on motion by Larry Arnold, second by Jesse Ours and passage by the members present.

Treasurer: Treasurer Larry Arnold gave the financial report. Starting balance: \$2355.03. Donations to Utility Fund: \$93.00 including \$72.00 from the donation jar and \$21.00 from 50/50. Donations from the public at the Young Eagles Rally: \$120.85. Sale of T-shirts, hats and coffee mugs: \$153.00. Dues collected: \$12.00. Expenses: \$412.51. Reserves: Utilities \$142.66; Young Eagles \$0.00. Ending Balance: \$2321.37. Motion to accept the report was made by Michael Harris, seconded by Tom McFadden and passed by the members present. Tom then made a motion that the \$120.85 contributed to the public be assigned to the Young Eagles reserves. The motion was seconded by Bernie Volpe and passed by the members.

Newsletter Editor: Nothing to report.

Membership: Dale reports that he is going to contact the CAP and bring some of the cadets out for hands-on ground schooling with his airplane.

Airport Board: Bill Corban reported on the removal of trees on the approach end of runway 9. Bill said the board is waiting to hear about a grant from the state and then the trees will be trimmed. Bill asked that all pilots respond in an affirmative manner when asked by non-flyers (possible obstruction owners) about the need to have the trees trimmed.

Old Business

- Bill Corban has replaced the screen door on the rear of the clubhouse and will be submitting a bill for the door.
- Kitchen faucet is plugged up again. Keith Homstad volunteered to try and fix it.
- Fly-In planning: Larry Arnold encourages everyone to sell ads for the newspaper that will be printed for the event. Carl Oblinger reports that his Radio Control Airplane club will participate at the fly-in.

New Business:

- Tim Hail donated a stapler and a tape dispenser, each with an airplane mounted on them.
- Larry reported that the project to paint the beacon house has been moved to June 30th and is asking for volunteers to come out and help. Rollie has several motorcycle-riding buddies that are willing to help with the project on the 30th.
- On behalf of Charlie Rhoads, who was not present, Larry asked George Fackler if we could hold the July meeting at George's hideaway.

Announcements


- Wendy is in frequent contact with Susan Reid. The Jerrie Mock statue fundraiser is now only about \$12,000 short and may be getting a grant.
