
## Fly-Out Report

## Minutes of October 16, 2012 EAA 402 Meeting

The meeting held at the clubhouse was called to order by President Bob Boyd at 1900 hrs. There were thirteen members and one visitor, Matthew Jernejcic, present. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

**Secretary:** The minutes of the September 2012 meeting were accepted as printed in the October 2012 newsletter on motion by Ken Hughes second by Rollie Bailey and passage by the members present.

**Treasurer:** Treasurer Larry Arnold gave the financial report. Starting balance: \$2320.78. Income: Donations to utility fund: \$10.00; 50/50 \$29.00; Ad payment \$50.00. Expenses: \$244.28. Reserves: Utilities \$6.76; Young Eagles \$0.00. Ending Balance: \$2,165.50. Motion to accept the report was made by Jesse Ours, seconded by Michael Harris and passed by the members present.

### Old Business

Bernie Volpe, Young Eagles coordinator, could not be at the meeting but passed along his thanks to all the pilots and ground volunteers who made the Young Eagles Rally of September 15th a success.

### New Business

- Planning for the Christmas Dinner Meeting has begun. Larry and Tom have both inquired about locations and caterers for the event. Larry has arranged with Mayor Mark Johns to be the guest speaker. Tom reported on the Buckingham House. The cost would be \$200 for the room and about \$16 per plate. The meal would be catered by Doug's Farside Catering. Larry checked out several other places and he recommended the Davis Shai House. The facility rental would be \$345 and the meal would be \$23 per plate. Other places were mentioned and considerable discussion was held. The Davis Shai House was highly favored for its atmosphere and beauty, especially when decorated for the holiday season. Larry made a motion that we go with the Davis Shai House. The motion was seconded by Rollie Bailey and passed unanimously by the members. Larry will make the final arrangements with Davis Shai House and caterer. Larry presented the menu possibilities and the following menu was chosen: Roast Beef Au jus, Boneless Skinless Breast of Chicken, Tossed Salad, Scalloped Potatoes, Country Green Beans, rolls, butter, iced tea and coffee. The chapter will have a theme cake made. Michael Harris volunteered to get the cake made. Michael estimates the cake will cost about \$100. **Announcements**

- YE Parent Waivers. The president showed a new form he has received from EAA. It is a “parent waiver” form which can be used in the event a pilot wants to fly a parent on a young eagle flight. There was some discussion about flying parents and all agreed we would do so in a limited number of cases but not promote it.
- The secretary informed the members that he has loaned Captain Peter Morford of the CAP a key to the clubhouse on an open-ended basis.

**Fly-Outs:**

- The third-Saturday fly-out, October 20th, will be to Amelia’s Restaurant in Cannan Valley, WV. Depart VTA at 8:00 AM and land at Windwood Airport (WV62), elevation 3210’. Rollie says this is a beautiful resort area with affordable rates in case someone wants to stay over.

**Program:** Mark Long, our newest chapter member, made a presentation of David Algie’s LP-1. Using videos and slide show, Mark told the story of designer David Algie and his work-in-progress on a carbon fiber two-place, pressurized-cockpit plane which uses a Corvett LS turbo charged engine. The plane is currently in taxi testing and should have first flight tests soon. It is expected to cruise at 385 mph on 14.5 gph fuel consumption. The design will be marketed as a kit by Woodward Aerospace. The chapter members at the meeting thoroughly enjoyed Mark’s presentation and sincerely thank him for taking the time to attend the meeting.
