

Minutes of November 20, 2012 EAA 402 Meeting

The meeting, held at the clubhouse, was called to order by President Bob Boyd at 1845. There were nineteen members and one visitor, Randy Kerr, CMH ATCT present. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Reports

Secretary: In the absence of Secretary McFadden, President Bob Boyd requested approval of the minutes from the October 2012 meeting as printed in the November 2012 newsletter. A motion was made by Larry Arnold, seconded by Rollie Bailey and approved by the members.

Treasurer: Treasurer Larry Arnold gave the financial report. Starting balance: \$2,165.50. Donations to Utility Fund: \$113. Dues collected: \$42.00. Member Christmas dinners paid: \$299.00. Guest Christmas dinners paid: \$92.00. Expenses: \$115.66. Ending balance: \$2,595.84 which includes a Utility Reserve of \$127.04. Motion to accept the report was made by Rollie Bailey, seconded by Roger Digel-Barrett and passed by the members. Larry was busy collecting dues from members (\$12 single; \$18 family) and money for the Christmas dinner (\$23 per person).

Airport Board: Bill Corban reported ongoing work towards removing obstructions from the approach end of runway nine (trees). Bids have been received by the board ranging from \$49,975 to \$160,000 but nothing approved yet until consideration has been made for securing the funding for the project. Still discussing options to re-align the taxi way.

Fly-Outs: Rollie Bailey reported five aircraft made the trip for breakfast to Urbana Grimes on Saturday November 17th. Rollie also said George Fackler was having his annual get together at the FBO on December 11 starting around 1700-1730 hours. George has graciously invited us over the past several years to participate in this very nice social affair.

Newsletter Editor: Wendy Hollinger reported on the trip that she and Dale made to Florida to visit with Jerrie Mock. She and Dale collected a vast array of facts including over 800 pictures. They will be looking for sponsors to help republish the original book, a companion book and perhaps a motion picture.

Membership Chair: Dale Ratcliff attempted to recruit Jerrie Mock to no avail. Old Business

Rollie mentioned the awning for the back of the clubhouse. Dan Glaze and Wayne Green are rescheduling this project to next year.

New Business

Dick Purdue approached airport management about restoring the aircraft tug to service. Larry Arnold and Bill Corban both indicated that the airport board is supportive of funding this project but they would like to know how much funding is required. Dick is to evaluate the matter further.

Larry Arnold noted maintenance required to the clubhouse to wit: exterior paint flaking and gutters in need of cleaning. Both projects were recommended to be considered after winter. Rollie volunteered to clean the gutters. Larry wants to be present to hold the ladder so Rollie does not have

an accident citing serious injuries occurring while performing this type of work.

50/50 Drawing: The 50/50 drawing was won by Michael Harris and he donated his winnings of \$13.50 to the utility fund. A total of \$27.00 went into the treasury.

Utility Fund Collection: A collection was taken up for the utility fund - \$40 collected.

Nominations and elections of officers: The nomination process, conducted by the acting secretary, was reopened. There were no new nominations and the slate stood with one nomination for three of the offices: for president, Bob Boyd; for treasurer, Larry Arnold; for secretary, Tom McFadden. On a motion by Rollie Bailey, seconded by Dale Ratcliff and a unanimous vote by the members the nominees were elected by acclamation. A written ballot vote was conducted for the office of vice president to decide between the two nominees Rollie Bailey and Casey Granger. The votes were counted and Rollie Bailey won in a close election.

Adjournment: Motion to adjourn was made by Wendy Hollinger, seconded by Tim Hail and passed by the members present. The meeting was adjourned at approximately 1950 hours and the floor was turned over to Randy Kerr, controller at CMH, for a presentation on his experience at this year's AirVenture at Oshkosh, WI. Randy shared pictures and stories of volunteering as an air traffic controller for the week where it is the busiest airport in the world. Randy discussed the layout of mobile towers and personnel controlling departures while those in the tower dealt strictly with landings – generally three aircraft at a time. Randy reported observing one aircraft land with a failed engine and no ensuing damage while another aircraft landed with a brake problem which caused a loss of control and quite a bit of property damage but no serious injuries.

The next meeting is December 18 at the Davis-Shai House starting at 6:00 PM.
