





## Minutes of January 15, 2013 EAA 402 Meeting

The meeting, held in the chapter clubhouse at 520 Heath Road, Heath, Ohio, was called to order by President Bob Boyd at 6:50PM. There were eighteen members present. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

### Reports

**Secretary's Report:** The minutes of the December 2012 meeting were read by the secretary. On motion by Rollie Bailey and second by Ralph Brandon the minutes were accepted as read by the members in attendance.

**Treasurer's Report:** Treasurer Larry Arnold gave the financial report. Starting balance was \$4,019.26. Dues paid for 2013: \$36.00. Advanced payments received for the Christmas dinner: \$368.00. Newspaper advertisement payment received from LCCVB: \$100.00. Expenses paid: \$2,921.93. Ending balance: \$1,601.33. Utility reserves: \$102.93. Young Eagles Reserves: \$0.00. A motion to accept the treasurer's report was made by Wendy Hollinger, seconded by Tom McFadden and passed by the members present. Larry reminded all that 2013 dues are due.

**Fly-Out Report:** Rollie Bailey reported that the fly-out to Salem did not go because of a combination of bad weather and illness of the coordinator. Next fly-out will be Saturday, January 19th, and will be to Clermont County Airport (I69) to visit Sporty's Pilot Shop and get free hot dogs for lunch. Departure will be at 10:30AM, weather permitting.

**Newsletter Editor:** Wendy Hollinger apologized for not being able to get a newsletter out for January, 2013. Wendy also reported that Brian Eley has volunteered to take up writing the Members Wing column of the newsletter.

**Membership Coordinator:** Dale Ratcliff reports that he has talking with potential pilots including "Mr. Brown," the UPS driver who delivers to his location.

**Web Editor:** Gary Kurtz asked that Rollie supply him with Fly-out information so he can post them on the web site in advance of the dates.

### New Business

The secretary suggested we update our chapter by-laws since the national guidelines have changed greatly since the 402 by-laws were written. The secretary volunteered to do the re-writing if the members agreed. A motion, made by Larry Arnold and seconded by Ken Hughes, was voted on and passed by the members to authorize the secretary to re-write the by-laws. The final product will be subject to approval of the membership. - Carl Oblinger suggested we buy a new outdoor grill and cover as the old one has gotten pretty beat up. Larry Arnold made a motion that we authorize Carl to do so. The motion was seconded by Rollie Bailey. After some discussion an approximate dollar amount of \$300 was set, a vote was taken and the motion passed.

**Builders Projects:** Bob Boyd reports that he is just getting back on the KR2 project and has ordered a tube bender to use in making fuel lines, pitot tube, etc. He is also planning to install wing tanks instead of the behind-the-pilot fuel tank.
