FLIGHT REVIEW WEEKEND

On **April 25-26, 2014**, the Ohio State Flight Training Clinic will be conducting flight reviews. Classroom study will be on the 25th at 6p and then various flight slots will be available for the 26th. Flight reviews are required by the FAA every 24 months. Please sign up for the class and flight slot. Cost of the weekend will be \$50 for the class and minimum of 1 hour in aircraft at \$160/hr in a Cessna 172.* You must have the classroom work done before the flight. If you have your own plane, the cost of the instructor only will be charged for the flight. Rain day will be May 3rd.

Minutes of February EAA 402 Meeting

The meeting was called to order by President Charlie Rhoads at 7:00 PM. There were 15 members and 1 visitor, Cheryl Houdesel, present. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. President Rhoads welcomed the members and visitor.

Secretary's Report: A motion to accept the minutes of the January 21st meeting was made by Ralph Brandon and seconded by Jess Ours. The minutes were approved by the members.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Ken Hughes gave the financial report. The starting balance was \$842.12. Income from dues paid: \$114.00. Income from donations: \$99.00. Income from 50/50 drawing was \$24.00. Expenses paid: Water Bill of \$13.12. Ending balance: \$1,066.00. Utility reserves: \$280.87. Young Eagles Reserves: \$64.93. Ending balance less reserves was \$720.20. Motion was made by Rollie Bailey, seconded by Bob Boyd and passed by the members present.

Fly-Out Report: Rollie Bailey reported that fly-outs this winter have been difficult because of the severe winter weather. Next scheduled Fly-outs are March 2nd, first Sunday of the month, depart VTA 10:30 a.m. to Port Clinton (PCW) for brunch at the Tin Goose and the third Saturday fly-out is scheduled for departure from VTA at 8:30 a.m. to Zanesville (ZZV) and breakfast at Denny's.

Newsletter Editor: Wendy was not present but sent an apology via Dale. Wendy apologized for not having a picture of Carl Braddock's new plane and instead putting picture of Rollie's plane on the front page of the chapter newsletter.

Membership: Dale says he keeps talking to people and promoting GA every chance he gets. Dale also mentioned that the Columbus Foundation will be unveiling a statue to Jerrie Mock at Port Columbus on April 17th. The event is by invitation only. Dale said anyone who wants to attend may submit their name to Wendy and she will try to get them an invitation.
